Freedom Select benefits are available to Ulster Savings Bank customers 50 years or better. There is a maximum of two individuals per household for Freedom Select membership; the lead individual must maintain combined deposit balances of \$25,000 or more and the second party must have an account relationship with USB. An active personal checking account relationship is required. Your account will be considered inactive if, for two consecutive years a deposit is not made to the account or a withdrawal is not made from the account. Member benefits are available as long as minimum balances are maintained. Program benefits and requirements for participation can be changed upon 30 days notice, provided that any change applies to all members.

The museum is a popular attraction located in the Catskills at the site of the 1969 Woodstock Festival, on the grounds of the original Max Yasgur's Dairy Farm in Bethel. We will have a docent-led tour of the museum, which opened to the public in June 2008. The museum is housed in a beautiful LEED-certified (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) green building, set back from the top of the festival hillside. There will be an hour of free time after the tour.

20th Century Masters

9 to 5 The Musical

Thursday, July 16, 2020

SPAC's NYC Ballet 20th Century Masters program will pay homage to iconic choreographers Merce Cunningham, Jerome Robbins, and George Balanchine.

Highlighting the program is Cunningham's *Summerspace*, which has not been performed at SPAC since 1967. Imbued with fluid angularity, Merce Cunningham's *Summerspace* presents contemporary whimsy underscored by a suspenseful, chirping score.

Displaying Robbins' penchant for crafting diverse emotional atmospheres to solo piano pieces, *Piano Pieces* is a folk-tinged ballet for three couples, a male soloist, and a corps de ballet that contrasts delicate solemnness with congenial amusement.

Closing the program is Balanchine's *Rubies*, which sends its dancers racing across the stage like lightning to Stravinsky's jazz-inflected piano capriccio, emphasized by a sharp attack and sassy style. Lunch will be included at The Hall of Springs Dining Room.
