



ULSTER SAVINGS NOW SHOWCASING PAINTINGS BY ESTELLE TAMBAK IN LAKE KATRINE BRANCH

Ulster Savings Bank would like to invite the public to their **1571 Ulster Avenue, Lake Katrine** (Ulster Commons) branch to celebrate the artwork of **Estelle Tambak**. The exhibit, made available through Cornell Street Studios in Kingston, will be on display at the branch through Thursday, December 1st.

Ms. Tambak, who died in 2002 at 88 years old, was a self-taught painter whose career spanned nearly 60 years. A world traveler over the years, her work reflected the joy she took from recording the variety of life she found during those travels. With training in early childhood education, Ms. Tambak was invited to teach Jewish orphans in post-Holocaust Poland in 1947. Upon returning to the United States, she taught in public schools and founded the River Park Nursery on Amsterdam Avenue in New York City in 1967. The school was based on a progressive multi-cultural and child-empowering program far ahead of its time. The school remains in operation to this day, a testament to the enduring power of her message. A portion of proceeds from sales of her artwork are donated to scholarship funds at River Park Nursery.
