ULSTER SAVINGS CHARITABLE FOUNDATION AWARDS \$10,000 GRANT TO THE JEWISH FEDERATION OF ULSTER COUNTY

The Ulster Savings Charitable Foundation recently awarded the Jewish Federation of Ulster County a \$10,000 grant in support of their ongoing restoration of the historic Reher Bakery building in the Rondout-West Strand Historic District of Kingston.

The restoration, once completed, will allow the Reher Bakery building to serve as the permanent home of the Reher Center for Immigrant Culture and History. It will serve Kingston residents, visitors to the area and surrounding communities with programs, exhibits and educational activities focusing on a local mercantile and social history of the region. The building, built in the 19th Century, is included in the National Register of Historic Places.

“The Reher Bakery buildings, once finished, will serve as a multi-faceted community resource in Kingston’s former industrial hub,” said MaryRose Warcholak, Executive Director of the Ulster Savings Charitable Foundation. “The Charitable Foundation is excited to lend its support to this great cause in the Kingston community.”
