



MARILYN PERRY PAINTING EXHIBIT TO BE FEATURED AT ULSTER SAVINGS BANK'S GARDINER BRANCH

Ms. Perry, a Gardiner resident returning for her third exhibition at Ulster Savings Bank, creates her art using both modern (acrylics) and ancient (encaustics – using molten beeswax) painting methods. Her semi-abstract landscapes and seascapes reflect the beauty and evanescence of elements in constant motion – seascapes, clouds, mists, water vistas, storms, moonlight, fire and shadows.

Ms. Perry's work has been shown in New York City and other venues and her career has been chronicled in such publications as the Wall Street Journal, Bloomberg News and the Gardiner Gazette. She is a member of the Gardiner Open Studio Tour (GOST). Prior to beginning her life as an artist in 2008, she focused her energies into philanthropy in the New York City area, including service as the President of the Samuel H. Kress Foundation (1984-2007) and as Chairman of the World Monuments Fund (1990-2007).
